

## HRA DUES AND POINTS COMMITMENT

**Huron Crew dues are per season!

**Note:**

*There may also be a surcharge for rowers attending overnight regattas!*

**DUES:**

Dues are seasonal and must be paid by the Friday of the *second* week of practice in the fall and by the Friday of the *first* week of practice in the spring. The season's Orientation Meeting is typically held before this due date. We will allow a grace period of one week to pay dues *for new rowers only*. **If payment of dues and required waivers and permission forms are not received by the deadline, rowers will not be permitted to practice with the team.**

**POINTS:**

In addition to dues, each rower is committed to earning at least 400 crew points within each season. These are points earned for helping with fundraising activities or doing regatta support helping on a committee. Points are valued at \$1 per point. Families with two or more rowers on the team within the same season will only have to earn 300 points per rower per season. Payment of dues by the due date mentioned above will entitle the rower to 50 crew points right away for that season.

**Note:** If you need to pay your points up front and in cash along with your team dues because you are not able to participate in any of the fundraising or regatta support activities, please contact one of the board members and we will try to accommodate you. We do prefer that all rowers and families, however, do participate in the fundraising and regatta support activities. Therefore we discourage that you prepay points. The fundraising we ALL do helps keep out costs and dues down.

Fall crew season is from August 1 – February 28(29). Spring crew is from March 1 – July 31. If you have a points shortfall at the end of a season, you will be invoiced at \$1 per point short and required to pay this amount. **Rowers will not be permitted to practice or row with the team until we receive payment of any points shortfall from a prior season.**

Rowers earning MORE than 400 points per season may carry over these points to the following season. A points shortfall may not be made up in a subsequent season. Points may be earned in various ways. *See the Orientation Handbook for details and more information on earning points!*

**IMPORTANT for Second Semester Seniors: second semester seniors with a points shortfall may not participate in the last regatta of the season unless the shortfall is paid one day before the first day of the last regatta of the season!**
